Getting There and Car Parking

Charlton Park, Malmesbury, Wiltshire, SN16 9RU.

Access to the venue will be from 07:45

On arrival, please use the business park entrance, we recommend the use of the What3Words App <https://w3w.co/sandwich.wand.punters> will take you to the main entrance through the business park.

Please park as directed by the carparking attendants.

There is a £5.00 charge for parking, cash only, please have it ready to pay as soon as you arrive.

Registration and Timing Chip Collection

Registration for the event will be from 07:50 and will be in the main arena.

You will be given your timing chip, which is to be securely placed on your ankle, we will also write your race number on your forehead!

Timing Chips

The timing chips will ensure that your finish results (as well as splits and lap times) are collected by the system. Remember, no timing chip, no results. Your timing chip must be firmly attached to your ankle using the velcro strap provided. **You must hand your timing chip back in when you finish the event or if you DNF.**

On The Day Entries

Limited on the day entries will be available at a cost of £65.00

Warm up and Mandatory Pre-Race Briefing

There will be a briefing and optional warmup in the start pen approximately 10 minutes before your wave is due to start.

Wave Start Times

You will have now received your wave start time. Please ensure you are in the start pen 10 minutes before your wave start time. Please note that wave times cannot be changed.

The Route

The race starts and finishes in the main arena. The route is approximately 4 miles per lap. You can view the course [HERE!](#)

Obstacles

The race will see the return of many of your favourite obstacles including of course The Travelator. Whilst we would love you to complete each obstacle, it is not compulsory, so if you see one and think no thanks, that is not for me you are welcome to go round the obstacle and carry on.

NB - If you are competing in the elite wave, you will have a standing time penalty of 60 seconds at each obstacle you do not complete.

Finish

The finish is on top of the all-important Travelator! You can stop here to have your photo taken if you so wish. Once down from the Travelator you can cross the line and collect that all-important beautiful very environmentally friendly medal, made in the UK from sustainable materials, as your reward for such a fantastic effort!

Spectators

Spectators are permitted at this event. We encourage spectators to watch from the main arena where you can see some of the great Rough Runner obstacles. We ask that spectators do not go anywhere else on course. Spectators are **NOT** permitted to use any of the obstacles.

Dogs

Dogs are welcome at this event; please ensure they are kept on a tight lead and you clean up any poop behind them!

#RoughRunnerSelfie

We'll have a #RoughRunner competition. There will be a couple of selfie boards on site and everyone that posts a photo to Twitter or Instagram with the hashtag #RoughRunner will go into the draw for..... wait for it, a free entry to the next Rough Runner event.

Go-Pros

The use of Go-Pros and other recording devices is permitted; however, Rough Runner takes no responsibility for any loss or damage to the devices.

Toilets and Changing

There will be several portable toilets on site for use before and after the event. Changing facilities are also available and will be signed for competitors use.
